THE EPISTLE OF PAUL THE APOSTLE TO THE

PHILIPPIANS

CHAPTER 1

PAUL and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the **saints** (in) Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:

2 **Grace** *be* unto you, and **peace**, from **God** our **Father**, and from the Lord Jesus Christ.

3 I thank my **God** upon every remembrance of you,

4 Always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with **joy**,

5 For your fellowship in the **gospel** from the first day until now;

cised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.

13 For neither they themselves who are circumcised keep the law; but desire to have you circumcised, that they may glory in your flesh.

14 But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, (by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.

15 For (in) Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.

16 And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God.

17 From henceforth let no man trouble me: for I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus.

18 Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. A-men.
