14 Now because la ve have maintenance from the king's palace, and it was not meet forus to see the king's dishonor, therefore have we sent and certified the king:

15 That search may be made in the book of the records of thy fathers: so shalt thou find in the book of the records, and know that this city is a rebellious city, and knurful unto kings and provinces, and that they have 13 moved sedition 14 within the same of old time: for which cause was this city destroyed.

16 We certify the king that, if this city be builded again, and the walls thereof set up, by this means thou shalt have no portion on this side the river.

17 Then sent the king an answer unto Rehum the chancellor, and to Shimshai the scribe, and to the rest of their b companions that dwell in Samaria, and unto the rest beyond the river,

at such a time.

18 The letter which ye sent unto us hath been plainly read before

me, 19 And 16 I commanded, and search hath been made, and it is found that this city of old time hath 17 made insurrection against kings, and that rebellion and sedition have been made therein.

20 There have been mighty kings also over Jerusalem, which have ruled 'over all countries "beyond the river; and toll, tribute, and custom, was paid unto them.

21 18 Give ye now commandment to cause these men to cease, and that this city be not builded, until another commandment shall be given from me.

22 Take heed now that ye fail not to do this: why should damage grow to the hurt of the kings?

Now when the copy of king artaxerxes' letter was read before Rehun, and Shimshai the scribe, and their companions, they went up in "haste to Jerusalem unto the Jews, and made them to cease by "force and power."

5 But /the eve of their God was upon the elders of the Jews, that they could not cause them to cease, (iii) the matter came to Darius: and then they returned answer by letter concerning this matter.

6 The copy of the letter that Tatnai, governor on this side the river, and Shethar-boznai, hand his companions the Apharsachites, which were on this side the river, sent unto Darius the king:

7 They sent a letter unto him, wherein 3 was written thus;

Darius the king, all peace.

8 Be it known unto the king, that we went into the province of Judea, to the house of the great God, which is builded with great stones, and timber is laid in the walls, and this work goeth fast on, and prospereth in their hands. 9 Then asked we those effers, and said unto them thus, Who commanded you to build this house, and to make up these

walls?
10 We asked their names also, to certify thee, that we might write the names of the men that were the chief of them.

11 And thus they returned us answer, saying, We are the 'servants of the God of heaven and earth, and build the house that was builded these many years ago, which a great king of Israel builded and 'set up.

12 But kafter that our fathers had provoked the God of heaven unto wrath, he gave them into the hand of 'Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, the Chaldean, who destroyed this house, and carried the people away into Babylon.

13 But in the first year of "Cyrus"

13 But in the first year of "Cyrus-the king of Babylon the same king Cyrus made a decree to build this house of God.

14 And the vessels also of gold and silver of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took out of the temple that was in Jerusalem, and brought them into the temple of Babylon, those did Cyrus the king take out of the temple of Babylon, and they were delivered unto one, whose name was Sheshbazzar, whom he had made governor;
