2 And all the brethren which are with me, unto the churches of Galatia:

3 Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ,

4 Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:

5 To whom be glory for ever and ever. A-men.

6 I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:

7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

9 As we said before, so say I now again, if any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

10 For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

11 But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.

12 For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

13 For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in

the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:

14 And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers.

15 But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by his grace,

= separated from Jewish law,

16 To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood:

Eph.2:8

17 Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus .

This is 2nd trip to Damascus.

18 Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and abode with him fifteen days.

19 But other of the apostles saw I none, save James the Lord's brother.

20 Now the things which I write unto you, behold, before God, I lie not.

21 Afterwards I came into the regions of Syria and Ci-li-c'i-a;

22 And was unknown by face unto the churches of Judæa which were in Christ:

23 But they had heard only, That he which persecuted us in times past now preacheth the faith which once he destroyed.

24 And they glorified God in me.

CHAPTER 2

THEN fourteen years after I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and took Titus with me also.

This is 2nd trip to Jerusalem.

2 And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them

GALATIANS 3

that **gospel** which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to **them which were of reputation**, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.

3 But **neither** Titus, who was with me, being a Greek, **was compelled to be circumcised**:

4 And that because of **false brethren** unawares brought in, **who** came in **privily** to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that **they** might bring us into **bondage**:

= secretly - 2 Pt.2:1

2Jo.:10

5 To **whom** we gave place by subjection, no, not for an hour; that the **truth of the gospel** might continue with you.

6 But of **these who seemed to be somewhat**, (whatsoever **they** were, it maketh no matter to me: God accepteth no man's person:) for **they who seemed to be somewhat** in conference added nothing to me:

7 But contrariwise, when **they** saw that the **gospel of the uncircumcision** was committed unto me, as **the gospel of the circumcision** was unto Peter;

8 (For **he** that wrought effectually in Peter to the apostleship of the circumcision, **the same** was mighty in me toward the Gentiles:)

9 And when **James, Ce'phas, and John**, who seemed to be **pillars**, perceived the grace that was given unto me, **they** gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we **should go** unto the heathen, and **they** unto the circumcision.

10 Only **they would** that **we** should remember the poor; the same which I also was forward to do.

11 But when Peter was come to An'-ti-och, I withstood him to the face, because he was to be blamed.

Peter

12 For before that certain came from James, **he** did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, **fearing** them which were of the **circumcision**.

13 And the other Jews **dissembled** likewise with him; in-somuch that Barnabas also was carried away with their **dis-simulation**.

14 But when I saw that they walked not uprightly according to the truth of the **gospel**, I said unto Peter before **them** all, If thou, being a Jew, livest after the manner of Gentiles, and not as do the Jews, why compellest thou the Gentiles to live as do the Jews?

15 We **who are** Jews by **nature**, and not sinners of the Gentiles,

16 Knowing that a man is not **justified** by the works of the law, but by the **faith** of Jesus Christ, even we have **believed** in Jesus Christ, that we might be **justified** by the **faith** of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be **justified**.

18 For if I **build** again the **things** which I **destroyed**, I make myself a transgressor.

3 Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the **flesh**? — Moses law

4 Have ye **suffered** so many things in vain? if *it be* yet in vain.

5 **He** therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, *doeth he it* by the works of the law, or by the hearing of **faith**?

6 Even as Abraham **believed** God, and **it** was accounted to him for righteousness.

v.29 7 Know ye therefore that they which are of **faith**, the same are the children of Abraham.

8 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the **heathen** through **faith**, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, *saying*, (In) thee shall all nations be blessed.

9 So then they which be of **faith** are blessed with **faithful** Abraham.

10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, **Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things** which are written in the book of the law to do them.

11 But that no man is **justified** by the law in the sight of God, *it is* evident: for, **The just shall live by faith**.

12 And the law is not of **faith**: but, **The man that doeth them shall live in them**.

13 **Christ hath redeemed us** from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, **Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree**:

14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles (through) Jesus Christ; that we might receive the **promise of the Spirit** through **faith**.

15 Brethren, I speak after the manner of men; Though *it be* but a man's covenant, yet *if it be* confirmed, no man annulleth, or addeth thereto.

16 Now to Abraham and his

4690 (def.) offspring

= Isaac

seed were the **promises** made. **He** saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy **seed**, which is Christ.

17 And this I say, *that* the **covenant**, that was **confirmed** before of God (in) Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the **promise** of none effect.

18 For if the inheritance *be* of the law, *it is* no more of **promise**: but God gave *it* to Abraham by **promise**.

19 Wherefore then *serveth* the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the **seed** should come to **whom** the **promise** was made; *and it was ordained* by angels in the hand of a **mediator**.

20 Now a **mediator** is not a **mediator** of one, but **God** is one.

21 *Is* the law then against the **promises** of God? God forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given **life**, verily righteousness should have been by the law.

22 But the scripture hath concluded all under **sin**, that the **promise** by **faith** of Jesus Christ might be given to them that **believe**.

23 But before **faith** came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the **faith** which should afterwards be revealed.

24 Wherefore the law was our **schoolmaster to bring us** unto Christ, that we might be **justified by faith**.

25 But after that **faith** is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.

26 For ye are all the children of God by **faith** (in) Christ Jesus.

27 For as many of you as have been **baptized (into)** Christ have **put on** Christ.

28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one (in) Christ Jesus.

29 And if ye *be* Christ's, then

you record, that, if *it had been* possible, ye would have plucked out your own eyes, and have given them to me.

16 Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the truth?

17 **They** zealously affect you, but not well; yea, **they** would exclude you, that ye might affect **them**.

23 But he *who was* of the **bondwoman** was born after the **flesh**; but he of the **freewoman** was by **promise**.

24 Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount Si'-nai, which gendereth to **bondage**, which is **Agar**.

25 For this **Agar** is mount Si'-nai in Arabia, and **answereth** to Jerusalem which now is, and is in **bondage** with her children.

 9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.
 10 As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.
 11 Ye see how large a letter I have written unto you with mine own hand.
 12 As many as desire to make a fair shew in the flesh, they constrain you to be circum-

cised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.
